



Overnight Guests Code of Conduct

- Student is expected to behave within the University of Rochester MELIORA values of Equity, Leadership, Integrity, Openness to difference, Respect for others, and Accountability.
- Student must participate fully in provided event itinerary.
- Student may not leave University grounds.
 - Student must spend the night in the room of assigned Overnight Ambassador.
- Student must follow all University safety rules.
- Possession or use of alcohol and other drugs, fireworks, guns, and other weapons is prohibited.
- No violence, including sexual abuse or harassment will be tolerated. Bullying, including verbal, physical and cyberbullying, is prohibited.
- Use of tobacco products, including vape pens, is prohibited.
- Misuse, damage, or theft of property is prohibited.

We trust all participants in overnight programs to comply with the code of conduct. Visitors who violate the code of conduct may be subject to disciplinary action at the discretion of the University, including, but not limited to a call home, early departure from the program at the student's expense, and/or formal documentation of violation in the file on record within the Office of Admissions that will be included in the formal application to the University, should the student choose to apply.
