In this lecture, we'll discuss the emergence of a sense of self during early childhood and the ways in which this understanding is closely tied to children's developing awareness of other people as separate from themselves. These topics fit into a broader area of research on young children's emerging social awareness and thinking, which can provide great insight into the roots of human reasoning and into societal functioning at large.
